ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Teaching Positions as per amended UGC Regulations.

1. Assistant Professor:

- i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.

2. Associate Professor:

- i) A good academic record, with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
- ii) A Master's Degree with atleast 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale, Wherever grading system is followed).
- iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic / research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry with a minimum of seven publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC listed journals and a total research score of Seventy Five (75) as per the criteria given in **Appendix-II**,

Table 2 which is annexed at page no. 4, 5 & 6 of this notification.

Interview schedule will be communicated through the email id in due course of time to the candidates on their registered email. The appointment of selected candidate(s) shall be subject to the verification of antecedents, educational qualifications, experience and medical fitness.

It shall be the responsibility of the candidate to assess his/her own eligibility for the post for which he/she is applying in accordance with the prescribed qualifications, experience and submit the application duly filled-in, along with the desired information and documents as per the advertisement. Peer-Reviewed or UGC-listed Journals (Impact factor to be determined as per Thomson Reuters list):

Paper in refereed journals without impact factor 5 Points i): 10 Points Paper with impact factor less than 1 ii) 15 Points iii) Paper with impact factor between 1 and 2 Paper with impact factor between 2 and 5 20 Points (v) 25 Points Paper with impact factor between 5 and 10 v) 30 Points vi) Paper with impact factor >10

(a) Two authors: 70% of total value of publication for each author.

(b) More than two authors: 70% of total value of publication for the First/Principal/Corresponding author and 30% of total value of publication for each of the joint authors.

Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each.

Note:

- · Paper presented if part of edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.
- For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Co-supervisor. Supervisor and Co-supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.
- *For the purpose of calculating research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories
 of 5(b). Policy Document and 6. Invited lectures/Resource Person/Paper presentation shall have an upper
 capping of thirty percent of the total research score of the teacher concerned.
- . The research score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of six categories.
