Eligibility for B.Sc. in Optometry

- i. Candidates should have passed 10+2 with Science combination with Mathematics & Physics.
- ii. He/she has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or equivalent examination recognized by any Indian University or a duly constituted Board with pass marks (50%) in physics, Mathematics & chemistry.

OR

Diploma in Optometry after completing 12th class/ 10 +2 of CBSE or equivalent with minimum aggregate of 50% marks in physics, chemistry, Mathematics and biology provided the candidate has passed in each subject separately.

- iii. Admission to the course shall be made based on entrance recognised eligibility examination or merit in the entrance test conducted by the university.
- iv. He/she should attain the age of 17 years as on (current year) & maximum age limit is 30 years.
