



DETAILS OF CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM

B.Sc. in Zoology and Biotechnology

A. B.Sc. in Zoology combination

- a. Zoology – Chemistry – Botany
- b. Zoology - Chemistry – Microbiology

B. B.Sc. in Bio-Technology combination

- a. Bio-technology – Chemistry - Botany
- b. Bio-technology - Chemistry – Zoology

I. Major / Main Course (12 papers with 6 credits = 72 credits)

4 courses in each discipline.	12 papers with 4 credits = 48 credits	} 72 Credits
Major / main course practical / tutorials	12 papers with 2 credits = 24 credits	

II. Discipline Specific Elective (6 papers with 6 credits = 36 credits)

a. 2 paper from each discipline of choice	6 papers with 4 credits = 24 credits	} 36 Credits
including paper of interdisciplinary nature	6 papers with 2credits = 12 credits	

Department to decide choice of papers
including interdisciplinary nature in each discipline

- b. Elective course practicals / tutorials 6 papers with 2 credits = 12 credits
- 2 paper from each discipline of choice
- including paper of interdisciplinary nature

Optional dissertation or project work
in place of discipline elective paper
6 credits in 6 semesters

DSC – **Discipline Specific Major / Main Course**

DSE – **Discipline Specific Elective**

2 courses from the pool of courses offered under the main discipline / subject of study

AECC – **Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course**

Courses that leads to knowledge enhancement like (i) Environmental Science (ii) English / Communication / Modern Indian Language

SEC – **Skill Enhancement Course**

4 courses from pool of courses to provide value based / skill based knowledge which may contain both theory / lab / training / field work. The main purpose is to provide life – skills to increase the employability of students.
